

Hurricane Harvey Relief



Heart for Texas is a coalition of Lutheran organizations with the purpose of providing disaster relief to southeast Texas in the wake of Hurricane Harvey. They are boots on the ground. Salem Lutheran (Ben Marsh's new church) has organized a high school week of relief efforts for up to 300 students and their leaders.

Dates: July 8-15, 2018 **NEW DATES**

Location: Salem Lutheran in Tomball, TX

Total Trip Cost: \$555 per person (limit of 16 high school students; college age may attend if spots remain open after March 15) Student's cost can be as low as \$185 if student and/or the family participates in Trivia Night fundraiser and mission support letters (see section below for details).

Non-Refundable Deposit: \$50 per person

Registration and Deposit Deadline: March 15, 2018

Participant Balance Due: April 15, 2018 (\$135 due. If unpaid, spot reopens)

Deposit and participant portion balance could be all participant pays out of pocket!

Fundraising Balance Due: May 1, 2018 (\$185 due unless student helped with April 27 Trivia Night, Parent gathered a table of 8, or sponsorships equal to money due)

Mission Support Balance Due: June 1, 2018 (last \$185 due from mission support letter efforts. Any amount less than \$185 is participant's responsibility to pay.)

Included in registration cost: Transportation, housing and meals for Hurricane Harvey Relief, one t-shirt, all activities and relief projects

Minimum Age: 14 years by July 8 and completed 8th grade.

Supplies: All individuals should attempt to bring their own supplies and should have at a minimum:

- Work gloves
- Safety glasses
- Multiple N95 NIOSH approved masks (Each mask lasts approximately 4 hours)
- Long sleeved shirt and pants to help prevent serious skin infections
- Work boots or closed-toed shoes
