

St. Trinity Lutheran MISSIONS TRAINING CENTER

Description: Middle school servants will serve in a variety of ways both physically and relational throughout their trip. Projects will be assigned based on interest of the team coming but will include serving with a homeless outreach, helping host a day camp for under privileged children, and other projects helping equip partnering organizations to share God's Word. The morning will consist of more physical projects such as light construction or painting. The afternoon will consist if more relational projects that help the students experience ministry in new ways.

Total Trip Cost: \$300 per person (limit of 24 students) Student's cost can be as low as \$100 if student and/or the family participates in Trivia Night fundraiser and mission support letters (see section below for details).

Non-Refundable Deposit: \$50 per person

Registration and Deposit Deadline: March 15, 2018

Participant Balance Due: April 15, 2018 (\$50 due. If unpaid, spot reopens)

Deposit and participant portion balance could be all participant pays out of pocket!

Fundraising Balance Due: May 1, 2018 (\$100 due unless student helped with April 27 Trivia Night, Parent gathered a table of 8, or sponsorships equal to money due)

Mission Support Balance Due: June 1, 2018 (last \$100 due from mission support letter efforts. Any amount less than \$100 is participant's responsibility to pay.)

Included in registration cost: Housing and meals (staff present 24 hours a day in their secure school building with onsite kitchen and showers and air mattresses), project planning and leading by Extreme Faith staff, staff lead daily devotions and worship time, daily training on how to continue ministry at home, trip t-shirt.

Minimum Age: Completed 5th grade.

Trip Pre-meetings: Tentative dates for these meetings are May 20, June 3 and June 24. Times TBD. Other information to follow.

Our mission is to inspire participants to take next step in ministering to their home communities. This involves the participant experience ministry here in St. Louis in a variety of different capacities. The experience is designed to push the participant and adult leaders out of their comfort zone in a safe, fun and encouraging environment. All this is done so they can see God working in new ways and be inspired to take what they have learned home. Project time is balanced between physical labor and projects aimed more at relationship building. With a variety of projects, we increase the opportunity for students to see God working in new and exciting ways. We also provide a time of teaching, devotions, and worship each day where participants can process their experience and compare what they see here with their home communities. By the end of the week each team will have a written plan to continue ministry efforts at their own church.
